MSMJ's Responsibilities include:

The **MSMJ** is responsible for performing safe, efficient repairs to mechanical manufacturing equipment. The **MSMJ** is responsible for performing routine, preventative, emergency and improvement maintenance in their department and is responsible for providing emergency maintenance to the entire manufacturing facility, when on shift. Key to success in this job is the **MSMJ's** ability to work independently and to effectively communicate with the personnel in all departments.

Expected Capabilities

- Operates in a safe and efficient manner and uses Standard Operating and Control Procedures to meet this objective.
- May be required to participate on Continuous Improvement teams, participates at monthly Safety modules and monthly Safety & Communication meetings, and may assist in the compilation of Safety and Housekeeping audits.
- Maintains a high level of housekeeping in their work area.
- Conducts a formal visual inspection of all operating equipment during his/her shift.
- Communicates formally with his/her relief, and/or the Supervisor at the beginning and end of each shift.
- Enters, and closes work orders in the CMMS system. Queries work orders to determine job status.
- Works in conjunction with training Operators in performing product changeovers.
- Maintains equipment in good running order through regular inspections (PM's), maintaining a lubrication program, performing repairs, and making machine adjustments as necessary.
- Communicates with co-workers, internal suppliers, internal customers and Managers, to facilitate the timely completion of maintenance requirements.
- Ensures the department has the proper maintenance equipment and supplies to perform tasks properly.
- May solicit job quotations from outside suppliers as required.
- Must be qualified to safely operate machine shop equipment (lathes, saws, drills, presses) for machining parts and other tasks.

- Expected to troubleshoot and correct failures (breakdowns; e.g. why parts may be wearing abnormally) determine root causes and ensure they are resolved to prevent recurrence.
- Performs other duties as assigned by Management

The MSMJ may be required to (and not limited to) perform the following:

- Read pneumatic, mechanical and schematic drawings
- Use hand and power tools
- Set-up and use machine tools
- Use and care of precision measuring equipment
- Selection and use of materials and fasteners
- Selection and application of lubricants
- Rig and hoist
- Install and maintain material handling systems
- Install and maintain power transmission systems
- Install and maintain compressors and pumps
- Install, commission and maintain prime movers
- Weld, braze and solder
- Install and maintain bearings, seals and packing
- Install and maintain pipe systems and valves
- Install and maintain fans and blowers
- Install and maintain pneumatic systems
- Install and maintain hydraulic systems
- Perform preventive and predictive maintenance
- Troubleshoot PLC based systems
- ** Note: Installation and maintenance of equipment refers to the mechanical aspects only.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Overtime may be required.
- Must have own tools.
- Must have a valid driver's license and a vehicle.
- Must have the following two (2) current trades certificate licenses (Certificate of Qualification issued by the Ontario Ministry of Training, Colleges and Universities)
- Industrial Mechanic (Millwright)
- Industrial Electrician
- MSMJ must be able to read and comprehend Standard Operating and Safety Procedures, Operation and Maintenance manuals; must be able to write, in English, descriptive sentences that

communicate status of jobs/equipment, must be able to perform basic mathematics, with and without a calculator. The MSMJ must be able to demonstrate proficiency in these, and other, skills by successfully completing relevant testing.

- MSMJ is required to maintain current knowledge of technology related to trade qualifications.

Shifts available: Due to business requirements, work on other than assigned shift may be required.
